The TDLR requires that a Modular home undergoes three inspections by a third party inspector, Professional Engineer, or Registered Architect. The TDLR also requires that a Modular home has an engineered foundation plan which includes the foundation supporting the home, the anchoring system, the skirting, any decks porches and steps, and anything else attached to the home. The TDLR requires that anyone installing a modular home, its utilities, and its air conditioner must be licensed.

It is standard to value Modular Homes comparable to site built homes.
