
ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING A FRANCHISE TAX UPON PROVIDERS OF TELEPHONE SERVICE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF UHLAND, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UHLAND, TEXAS:


Section 1. From this date forward any person, association, cooperative or corporation that shall sell telephone services within the Town Limits of the Town of Uhlend, Texas, shall pay a franchise tax of two percent (2%) of the gross receipts received from the sale of such services. The payment of the franchise tax shall be for the privilege of doing such business within the Town Limits.

Dear Mr. Langley:

The Town of Uhland, Texas, was incorporated by vote of its citizens on January 19, 1985. Uhland lies in Hays and Caldwell Counties on State Highway 21--ten miles Northeast of San Marcos and six miles East of Kyle.

On August 7, 1985, the Board of Aldermen voted into effect a franchise tax of 2% of gross receipts on providers of telephone service within the Town limits. A copy of the Ordinance, and a copy of a map of the Town Limits, is enclosed.

Some of your customers on the Kyle Exchange are within the Town Limits of Uhland.

We will greatly appreciate your cooperation in this matter as we have not yet developed any revenue.
