

Ordinance No. 14

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE TOWN OF UHLAND,
TEXAS, TO THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UHLAND,
TEXAS:

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen find that the designation "Town" causes confusion; that Federal and State Agencies, and their computers, persist in designating the Town of Uhland the "City of Uhland" in correspondence and proposed contracts.

Section 2. The name of the community, "Town of Uhland" is hereby changed to "City of Uhland".

Section 3. All contracts heretofore entered into under the name "Town of Uhland" or "City of Uhland" are hereby in all things ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. The City of Uhland, and its officers, may continue to use any supplies printed with the designation "Town of Uhland" until the same are exhausted.
