

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING RULES GOVERNING PRIVATE SEWAGE FACILITIES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY'S JURISDICTION, AND WITHIN THE EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY: PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR APPROVAL AND INSTALLATION OF SUCH FACILITIES: AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS:

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen of the City of Uhland, Texas, does hereby find that the adoption of rules governing installation, maintenance, and use of private sewage facilities within the municipality's jurisdiction and extraterritorial jurisdiction will prevent pollution or injury to public health, and will promote the health, safety and general welfare of the community; and will promote the safe, orderly, and healthful development of the municipality.

Section 2. The City of Uhland does hereby adopt as the Rules of the City of Uhland, Texas, for Private Sewage Facilities those same and exact Rules of Caldwell County, Texas, for Private Sewage Facilities adopted by Order of the Commissioners' Court of Caldwell County entered June 14, 1982, as amended, and a true copy of said order shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of Alderman and filed with, and incorporated into, this Ordinance; however, the changes and amendments of Section 3 hereof shall apply to and be controlling as to such Order.

Section 3. Sections XIII and XIV of said Order are not adopted hereby. DEFINITIONS shall be construed as follows:

- a. Commissioners Court shall mean the Board of Alderman of the City of Uhland, Texas.
- b. Caldwell County shall mean the City of Uhland, Texas.
- c. County shall mean City.
- d. Standards shall mean "Construction Standards for On-Site Sewerage Facilities" adopted by the Texas Department of Health and effective January 1, 1988, as the same may be hereafter amended, or as they now exist.
- e. County Judge shall mean the Mayor.
- f. Clerk shall mean the City Secretary.

Section 4. A violation of this ordinance shall be punishable in the Municipal Court of the City of Uhland, Texas, upon conviction, by a fine of not to exceed \$500.00. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate violation.
