

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND REQUIRING THE PLACING OF A
STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF COTTON GIN ROAD AND OLD
SPANISH TRAIL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHLAND,
TEXAS:

The Council finds, based upon its studies and after holding a public hearing, that there is a necessity for a stop sign on Cotton Gin Road at its intersection with Old Spanish Trail in the City of Umland for the protection of the public;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council authorizes and requires City Officials to place, or cause to be placed, a stop sign on Cotton Gin Road at its intersection with Old Spanish Trail in the City of Umland. Such sign shall conform to the Texas Department of Transportation's manual and specifications as required by §31, Article 670ld, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes.

This ordinance is effective immediately.
