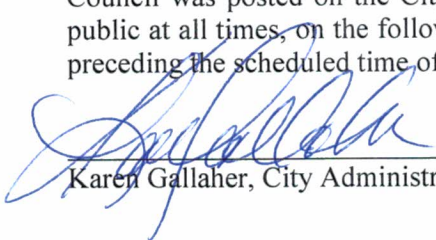
E. ADJOURNMENT
