ORDINANCE No. __130____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2012 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2013; AND PROVIDING FOR A CUMULATIVE CLAUSE, SEVERABILITY, SAVINGS, DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND PROPER NOTICE OF MEETING.

- WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on the proposed budget of the City of Uhland, Texas for the year 2012-2013 has been posted in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas;
- **WHEREAS**, a public hearing was duly held at the time and place as provided for in the notice of such public hearing and all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard on said proposed budget; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Texas Local Government Code requires that a City budget must be adopted annually;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF UHLAND, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

1. APPROVAL OF BUDGET

The proposed budget presented by the Mayor and made available for public review for one month prior to its adoption including all amendments thereto as a result of such review and public hearing is hereby approved and adopted for the fiscal year 2012-2013, as set forth in Appendix 1 hereof.

2. CUMULATIVE CLAUSE

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Uhland, Texas, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

That if any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

4. SAVINGS CLAUSE

That all previous budget ordinances shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this Ordinance.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE

The necessity for making and approving a budget for the fiscal year, as required by the laws of the State of Texas, requires that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as the law in such case provides.

6. PROPER NOTICE OF MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.
