ORDINANCE NO. 261

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS; APPOINTING KAREN GALLAHER TO SERVE AS THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR: REPEAL OF CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, A SAVINGS CLAUSE, MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Uhland, Texas is a Type A general law City incorporated and functioning as such under the provisions of Chapter 11, Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Section 22.071 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a Type a generallaw municipality may appoint municipal officers by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 22.072 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that the City Council of the City of Uhland, Texas may require a municipal officer whose duties are prescribed by the Texas Local Government Code to perform additional duties; and

WHEREAS, On the 5th day of May, 2021 the City Council of the City of Uhland promoted Karen Gallaher to the employment position title of City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, Karen Gallaher has continued to serve in the capacity of City Administrator through the date of this Ordinance.

WHEREAS, On April 7th, 2020 the City Council of the City of Uhland Texas formally created the Office and Position of City Administrator by Ordinance No. 261; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. APPOINTMENT.

The City Council of the City of Uhland, Texas herby affirms the appointment of Karen Gallaher to serve as the City Administrator for the City of Uhland, Texas from the effective date of this Ordinance until removed by Ordinance.

SECTION 2. CONFLICT.

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance or the application of any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision to any person or circumstance is adjudged to be invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision or applications thereof which can be given effect without

the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended or repealed.

SECTION 5. MEETING OPEN TO PUBLIC.

It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed is open to the public as required by law and that the public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and approval.
