AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE ELECTIVE OFFICE OF CITY MARSHAL; ESTABLISHING THE APPOINTIVE OFFICE OF CITY MARSHAL; PROVIDING A METHOD OF APPOINTMENT; ESTABLISHING QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS:

Section 1. The present office of City Marshal, which is filled by election, is hereby abolished, and henceforth no election shall be held to fill the position.

Section 2. There is hereby established the office of City Marshal. Said officer shall have all the rights, powers, duties and obligations of an elected City Marshal. No City Marshal shall be appointed prior to May 1, 1987.

Section 3. The City Marshal shall be appointed by the Mayor, and said appointment shall be subject to the affirmative approval of the Board of Aldermen. Said officer shall serve at the will and discretion of the Board of Aldermen.

Section 4. The Board of Aldermen shall set the salary of the office.

Section 5. The City Marshal shall be qualified to be a peace officer according to the laws of the State of Texas.
