



ORDINANCE NO. 285

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS SETTING THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR TO BE ELECTED AND THE COMPENSATION OF EACH OTHER ELECTED OFFICER TO BE ELECTED AT THE MAY 2023 REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Umland, Texas is a type a general law municipality; and

WHEREAS, on or before January 1, type a general law municipalities are permitted to set the salary of the Mayor and the compensation of each other elected officer to be elected at the following regular municipal election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Umland acknowledges the importance of public service officials; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Umland acknowledges the time commitment and dedication of public service officials; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Umland desires to preserve the integrity and professional image of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Umland acknowledges that minimal compensation for the time and dedication of public service officials promotes integrity and professionalism; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Umland has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to set a salary for the Mayor and compensation for each elected or appointed officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHLAND, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as the City of Uhland's "Ordinance for Mayor and City Council Compensation".

SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY.

This Ordinance shall apply to the officer position of Mayor and to any other officer position being elected at the May 2023 City of Uhland general election, and to any other such officer position appointed by the City Council after the May 2023 general election. The applicability and the compensation set forth herein shall expire at the end of each officer's elected or appointed term. All compensation authorized hereunder this Ordinance shall be paid in two payments on or after the 1st of each month and on or after the 15th of each month, to each person holding an eligible officer position respectively on the 1st and the 15th of that month.

SECTION 3. COMPENSATION.

4.1 Mayor Salary.

The salary for the position of Mayor is hereby set at \$1000.00 per month. The person elected at the May 2023 City of Uhland general election and any person appointed by the City Council after the May 2023 City of Uhland general election to the position of Mayor shall be paid a monthly salary of \$1,000.00.

4.2 Council Compensation.

The compensation for the position of Alderman (City Council Member) is hereby set at \$500.00 per month. The persons elected at the May 2023 City of Uhland general election and any person appointed by the City Council after the May 2023 City of Uhland general election to fill the Aldermen (City Council) officer positions of the City shall be paid a monthly salary of \$500.00.

SECTION 4. CONFLICT.

All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of any provision to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications thereof which can be

given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended.

SECTION 7. MEETING OPEN TO PUBLIC.


It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed is open to the public as required by law and that the public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and approval.


