Pursuant to Texas Government Code Sec. 551.0415, a member of the governing body may announce items of community interest during a meeting of the governing body without given notice of the subject of the announcement. Items of Community Interests include: (1) expressions of thanks, congratulations, or condolence; (2) information regarding holiday schedule; (3) an honorary or salutary recognition of public official, public employee, or other citizen, except that a discussion regarding a change in the status of a person's public office or public employment is not an honorary or salutary recognition of the subdivision; (4) a reminder regarding social, ceremonial, or community event organized or sponsored by an entity other than the governing body that was attended or is scheduled to be attended by a member of the governing body or an official or employee of the political subdivision; and (5) announcements involving imminent threat to the public health and safety of people in the political subdivision that has arisen after the posting of the agenda.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

All participants and speakers are hereby reminded of the City's Meetings and Agendas Policy.

In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's Opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the City Council. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, or comment will be made by the City Council. Public comments related to agenda items will be heard at the time the item is called.

Interested persons wishing to provide public comments at this meeting must submit a complete public comment request form to the City Secretary for each topic they wish to speak about no later than five (5) minutes **PRIOR** to the start of the. All public comment speakers will be allowed to speak for three (3) minutes on each topic for which they properly submitted a public comment request form.

[Note: The Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, prohibits the City Council from fully discussing, debating, or considering subjects for which public notice has not been given on the agenda. Issues that cannot be referred to the City Staff for action may be placed on the agenda of a future City Council Session.]

The following routine, clerical, and administerial items require no public hearing and are anticipated to require little or no individualized discussion by the City Council. It is intended that these items will be acted upon with a single motion as a collective, singular item.
