Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Uhland, Texas will hold a special meeting on Wednesday, July 12, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall at 15 North Old Spanish Trail, Uhland, Texas. Members of the public, City Council and city employees may participate in the meeting virtually, as long as a quorum of the City Council and the presiding officer are physically present at the Municipal Building, in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Some members of the City Council or city employees may be participating by videoconference and a quorum will be present at the location identified above.

Public comment will be allowed in person or remotely via telephone. Speakers may only register to speak on an item once, either in-person or remotely, and will be allowed up to three minutes to provide their comments. Registration no later than noon the day before the meeting is required for remote participation by telephone. Pursuant to Texas Government Code Sec. 551.0415, a member of the governing body may announce items of community interest during a meeting of the governing body without given notice of the subject of the announcement. Items of Community Interests include: (1) expressions of thanks, congratulations, or condolence; (2) information regarding holiday schedule; (3) an honorary or salutary recognition of public official, public employee, or other citizen, except that a discussion regarding a change in the status of a person's public office or public employment is not an honorary or salutary recognition of the subdivision; (4) a reminder regarding social, ceremonial, or community event organized or sponsored by an entity other than the governing body that was attended or is scheduled to be attended by a member of the governing body or an official or employee of the political subdivision; and (5) announcements involving

imminent threat to the public health and safety of people in the political subdivision that has arisen after the posting of the agenda.

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENT

All participants and speakers are hereby reminded of the City's Meetings and Agendas Policy.

In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's Opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the City Council. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, or comment will be made by the City Council. Public comments related to agenda items will be heard at the time the item is called.

Interested persons wishing to provide public comments at this meeting must submit a complete public comment request form to the City Secretary for each topic they wish to speak about no later than five (5) minutes *PRIOR* to the start of the meeting. All public comment speakers will be allowed to speak for three (3) minutes on each topic for which they properly submitted a public comment request form.
